Goal: Johnny will not get out of his seat
without permission no more than two times
per day.

Describe the student's INAPPROPRIATE behavior. Be specific with your description.

Johnny gets out of his seat frequently
throughout the day. This behavior is a
distraction to his classmates and the teacher
during the instructional time.

List the identified function or reason for the behavior.

Johnny is seeking attention ; therefore, he
gets out of his desk frequently during class.

Target Behavior(s) to decrease: Please try to limit the target behavior(s) to no more than two. Many identified behaviors can be combined into one behavior.

Note: This information must be stated in measurable terms (example: By the end of a 6 week period Joe will decrease attention seeking behavior of beating on the desk during instructional time by 0 incidences 100% compliance.

By the end of a 6 week period, Johnny will decrease attention seeking behavior of getting out of his desk without permission during instructional time to no more than two incidences per day.

Describe the APPROPRIATE behavior(s) that are desired from the student. What behavior(s) will replace the student's inappropriate behaviors? Be specific with your description.

Johnny will raise his hand to get permission before getting out of his seat.

List the reinforcers you will use to help increase the desired APPROPRIATE behaviors.

- 1) Johnny will receive verbal praise each time he follows the appropriate behavior.
- 2) Johnny will gain activities, such as free time, for following the appropriate behavior.
- 3) Johnny's mother will provide Johnny with special privileges at home for following the appropriate behavior.

List the consequences if the student does not comply with the behavior plan. Please note: Behavior plans must be discussed and developed with the student and should be coordinated with the parent.

- 1) Johnny will lose classroom privileges.
- 2) Johnny will sit during a part of recess.
- 3) Johnny's mom will be notified and she will revoke special privileges at home.

How will you measure your goal? What will constitute a continuation/discontinuation of this plan?

A behavior calendar will be used. Each time Johnny gets out of his seat on a daily basis, he will receive a tally on the calendar. If Johnny gets more than 10 tallies in a 5 day period, the plan should be revisited and revised.
